

Admin Queries

Student Care Centre (SCC)

- In-house SCC
- Community-based SCC located opposite the school (run by Morning Star Community Services)

Phase 2A Eligibility

- Only <u>former students of SACPS</u> are eligible
- Ex-students of Canossa Convent Primary will not be eligible

Phase 2B Priority

 <u>Parent</u> is a member endorsed by the church directly connected with the primary school - <u>Parent</u> must be a baptised Catholic and provide Baptism Certificate (not the child)



Admin Queries

Phase 3 Registration for International Students (IS) (Non-SC/Non-SPR)

- IS can only register for P1 during Phase 3 of the Registration Exercise, after all SCs and SPRs have been allocated a place under the earlier phases.
- Timeline for online indication of interest has passed
- MOE will notify IS applicants via email in October on the outcome of placement, and provide further guidance on registration.
